ANALOGIES

SKILL

IDIOMS

Comparing two items. Ex. A shoe and a sock go together as a hand and a ____. Understanding non-literal phrases.

EXAMPLES

MULTIPLE MEANINGS

Identifying and describing words that have more than one meaning. Ex. park, bowl, bat

Ex raining cats and dogs

DIFFERENCES

Telling how two or more objects are different Ex. How are a cat and a dog different?

SIMILARITIES

Telling how two or more objects are alike Ex. How are a cat and a dog alike?

CATEGORIZATION

Naming and identifying categories, synonyms and antonyms Ex. Name three fruits, give a synonym for cold.

ASSOCIATIONS

Naming and identifying what "goes together". Ex peanut butter and jelly

FUNCTIONS

Naming and identifying objects by their function Ex. What do you do with scissors?

LABELING

Naming objects and pictures of objects Ex. What is this? Where is ___?
